

Transportation of a Deceased Body

- A. Copy of Death Certificate.
- B. Copy of Burial Transit Permit.
- C. Copy of embalmment Certificate.
- D. A letter from the Health Department confirming that there was no contagious disease at the time of death.
- E. Passport/Birth Certificate or any acceptable form of identification of the diseased.
- F. Pre-paid self addressed return courier envelope from Xpresspost (it should have a tracking number). **NOTE: Other courier services are no longer acceptable.**
- G. Telephone number if available of Next of Kin or friends in (Canada/Cuba) and Kenya.

REQUIREMENTS FOR TAKING ASHES TO KENYA

- A. Copy of death certificate
- B. Certificate from the crematorium
- C. Certificate issued by the funeral director confirming that the contents are nothing but the remains and is not mixed with anything else.

D. Pre-paid self addressed return courier envelope from Xpresspost (it should have a tracking number).

NOTE: Other courier services are no longer acceptable.

On receipt of the above documents, the Consulate will issue a letter of no objection for the remains to be transported to Kenya. (No fee is charged for the service)
